Reading the Bible—*Josh Mann*



We often hear about the importance of reading and studying the Bible for ourselves, but sometimes we lack the motivation to spend the time it takes to do it. If you're in this boat, here is a suggestion.

Stop for a moment and consider exactly what the Bible is. It is not only a collection of 66 writings written by human authors over thousands of years; it is also a God-breathed book. These 66 books were written under God's inspiration—God speaking through human authors

(2 Timothy 3:16; 2 Peter 1:20-21).

We call the Bible the "Word of God" because within its pages is God's revelation of Himself, of His redemptive plan for humanity, and the truth about who we are and how we are to live. The Bible is the primary way God communicates to us.

In response to one of three temptations by Satan in the wilderness, Jesus quoted Deuteronomy 8:3, saying, "Man shall not live on bread alone, but on every word that proceeds

from the mouth of God" (Matthew 4:4). The implication of this verse is that the Word of God is as essential to our lives as food is to our physical bodies. Remember, Jesus hadn't eaten for 40 days and nights. As much His body needed food, he needed God's Word more.

Let's allow a better understanding of what the Bible is to motivate us to read, study and obey it more than ever. Just think, God has written to you, His child. We cannot afford to ignore Him.

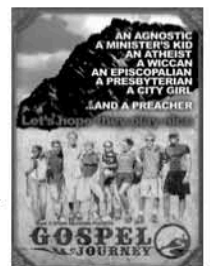
